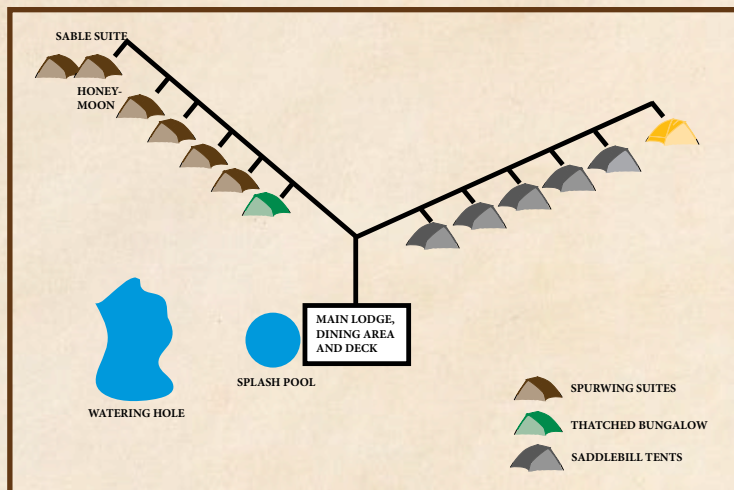




Bomani Tented Lodge is situated in a private concession of the magnificent Ngamo Plains, on the edge of the remote and unspoilt south eastern corner of Hwange National Park. Bomani is famous for its unique scenery as well as its large herds of elephants and all other animals and birdlife resident in Hwange. Our highly experienced knowledgeable guides will treat you to a safari experience you will never forget!



## LOCATION

- Situated on a 5000 acre private reserve within the Ngamo Forest Area, on the edge of the south eastern corner of Hwange National Park.
- 4 - 5 hour road transfer from Victoria Falls or Bulawayo.
- Distances by road: Victoria Falls – Halfway House 225 km, and 40 km through Forestry (4x4). Bulawayo – Kenmaur 170 km, and 68 km on Somgolo Road via Gwaai Siding and Sipepa growthpoint (4x4).
- 4 - 5 hour road and rail transfer from Victoria Falls.
- 1 hour small plane charter from Victoria Falls or Bulawayo.
- **Bomani Airstrip** - South 19 04 30.8 / East 027 27 22.7 (Please note that the Bomani Airstrip is only open seasonally. During the rainy season light air charters usually land and take off from Sipepa - about 1 hour drive from camp).
- **Sipepa Airstrip** - South 19 16 45.0 / East 027 38 54.0 (Gravel, open year round. One thousand one hundred metres long).
- Lodge co-ordinates are: South 19 04 41.49 / East 027 27 37.79

## ACCOMMODATION

- **1 x Thatched Bungalow:** 77 sq m tent with thatched roof and stone walls overlooking the lodge watering hole, queen-sized bed, overhead fans, en suite lounge, en suite changing room, shower basin and toilet.
- **1 x Spurwing Honeymoon Tent:** 57.5 sq m tent overlooking the lodge watering hole, king-sized bed, en suite shower and free standing bath, twin basins, overhead fans, large

tilled veranda ideal for private dining.

- **2 x Spurwing Twin Tents:** 62.5 sq m tent overlooking the lodge watering hole, twin double beds, overhead fans, en suite shower, toilet, basin, spacious seating area, veranda ideal for private dining, space for an extra bed for children.
- **1 x Spurwing Double Tent:** 62.5 sq m tent overlooking the lodge watering hole, king-sized bed, overhead ceiling fan, en suite shower, toilet, basin, spacious seating area, veranda ideal for private dining.
- **3 x Saddlebill Twin Tents:** 50 sq m tent with views across the Ngamo Plain to Bomani Pan, raised teak deck, twin double beds, standing fan, en suite shower, toilet and basin.
- **2 x Saddlebill Double Tents:** 48 sq m tent with views across the Ngamo Plain to Bomani Pan, raised teak deck, standing fan, en suite shower, toilet and basin. One of the rooms has a double bed, the other a kingsize bed.
- **1 x Sable Suite (Family Suite):** 250 sq m tent structure built on a raised wood deck composed of four sections. Two bedrooms, one with a kingsize bed and the other with twin ¾ beds. Both bedroom units have overhead fans and en suite bathrooms with toilet, basin, a bath and outdoor shower. The suite is completed with a tea/coffee station and mini bar fridge in the dining area, a lounge area with a veranda deck and views across the plains (2 extra ¾ beds and can be placed in the lounge area so the family suite can accommodate 6 pax).



## FACILITIES

- Main lodge comprising open fronted thatch building with teak viewing deck overlooking the lodge waterhole.
- Bar, lounge and dining room with overhead fans.
- Electricity by solar.
- Free Wifi in the main lodge.
- Cell phone reception.
- Splash pool set in raised wooden deck overlooking the lodge waterhole.
- In-house spa treatments available - not included in nightly rate, prices on request.

## ROOM AMENITIES

- Ceiling or standing fan.
- Emergency whistle and air horn.
- Electronic safe.
- Mosquito repellent.
- Mobile LED lamp.
- Free daily laundry (weather dependent).

## ACTIVITIES

Hwange National Park at 14,500 sq km, is one of Africa's great Parks and is home to over 100 species of mammals, including nineteen large herbivore and eight large carnivore species, and nearly 400 species of birds. Hwange is elephant country and much of the game viewing relates to magnificent opportunities to view these, the largest land mammals, in a completely wild state. The lodge estate is in an exclusive 5000 acre portion of Ngamo Forest adjacent to the Ngamo Gate into Hwange National Park, 1.5 km from the lodge. Game activities into the park are within a vast exclusive and wild area of the park.

## GAME DRIVES

- Morning and afternoon game drives with snacks in traditional open safari vehicles.
- All day game drives with a packed lunch and snacks in traditional open safari vehicles.
- Land Cruisers seat up to 9 guests and Land Rovers seat up to 7 guests.

## GAME WALKS

- Conducted by an experienced and knowledgeable guide.
- Usually undertaken in the mornings and ideal for photography of big game on foot.

## NIGHT DRIVES

- Night drives within the lodge's private concession to view the array of nocturnal creatures.
- Usually undertaken upon return from the afternoon activity or alternatively after supper.

## THE LOOK UP GAME VIEWING HIDE

- Experience Hwange's giants up close and only a few meters from the watering hole from the safety of this specialized 6m long underground blind with en-suite flush toilet.

## PUMP RUNS

- Imvelo maintain 18 water pumps in and on the borders of the National Park which provide essential water to the wildlife during the dry months of the year. A popular activity is to take an all day trip into the Park to visit the waterholes to drop off fuel and oil for the motors as well as rations and supplies for the pump attendants.
- A picnic lunch is then enjoyed near one of the waterholes followed by a leisurely game drive back to lodge in the afternoon.

## NGAMO COMMUNITY EXPERIENCE

- Fifteen minutes drive from the lodge our guests have the opportunity to enjoy a look at village life in rural Matabeleland. A fascinating experience of a variety of typical daily village activities, which can be followed by a tour of one of the nearby schools conducted by the Headmaster where guests are given the opportunity to hear traditional songs sung by the children and enjoy a 'class interaction'.
- \* *School visits not available in April, August and December - Mid January during school holidays.*

## NGAMO WILDLIFE SANCTUARY

- Imvelo have partnered with the Ngamo community to set up a wildlife sanctuary on their land. This is the home of our famed Cobras Community Wildlife Protection Unit – visitors are welcomed to Head Quarters where they can meet some of the Cobras and gain an understanding of the scope and vision of this exciting pilot project, as well as of Imvelo's broader community and conservation commitments. Visits do need to be arranged in advance to avoid disrupting the Cobras' daily program and responsibilities. ## RATES INCLUDE

## CANCELLATION POLICY

- 30 days + before travel = 75% refund.
- 16 - 29 days before travel = 50% refund.
- 8 - 15 days before travel = 25% refund.
- 0 - 7 days before travel or non arrivals = no refund.

## CHILDREN

- Children under the age of 7 are only allowed by special arrangement subject to restrictions, particularly to do with private dining options and a separate vehicle for game drives and is at the sole discretion of lodge management.
- Children aged 12 and below pay 50% on accommodation portion only and must share with an adult.
- Up to 2 children may share a tent with an adult.
- 4 children and 2 adults can be accommodated in the Sable Suite.

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
